Personalized Dried Flower Candles

Materials

- Pillar Candles
- Pressed Flowers
- Flat nose tweezers
- Old stainless Steel Spoon
- Scissors
- Wax paper
- Hairdryer or hot air gun



Instructions



1. Lay out flower design.
2. Light a candle.
3. Heat an old spoon over the candle. You'll need it to get warm enough to melt the wax of the candle.
4. Place the foliage on the candle, and smoothly glide the curved side of the spoon over. If your spoon starts getting ashy, make sure to wipe it clean with a paper towel so the ash doesn't transfer to your candle.

For bigger pieces like leaves, you will need to melt the wax under the pressed piece. It's like gluing it down before doing a wax coat over it

5. Smooth over any and all loose ends over to keep the foliage in place.



OPTIONAL

6. Cut a strip of wax paper and place around entire candle, trying to make sure there are not any air bubbles under the paper.
7. Take a hairdryer or heat gun, turn it on and point it at the candle. The upper layer of candle wax will start melting together with the tissue paper.
8. slowly pull the wax paper off. Leave the candle alone to set for half and hour.

Personalized Tissue transfer candles

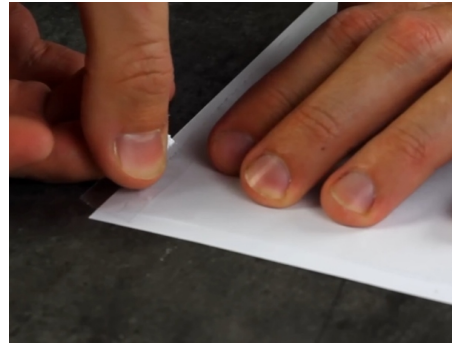
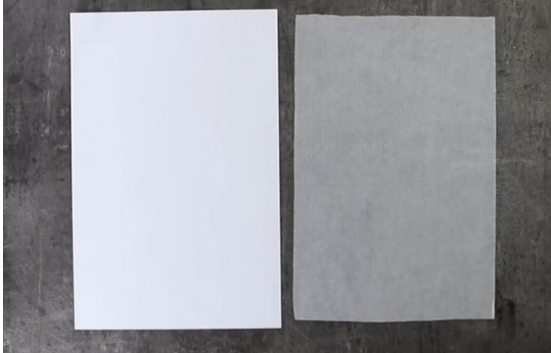
Materials

- Pillar Candles
- Tissue paper
- Copy paper
- Printer
- Scissors
- Tape
- Wax paper
- Hairdryer or hot air gun



Instructions

1. Trim the tissue paper. Make it smaller than a piece of copy paper.
2. Tape the tissue paper, with shiny side down, onto the printer paper.



3. Put the prepared page into the printer so that it prints onto the tissue side and choose the picture you want to be placed on your candle. Then print it out.
4. Cut the picture and leave a small margin right around it.

Use the following steps when using tissue that has been traced, drawn or written on.

5. Put the photo across the middle of the candle. Over it put a sheet of wax paper trying to make sure there are not any air bubbles under the paper.
6. Cut a strip of wax paper and place around entire candle, while making sure there are not any air bubbles that exist under the paper.
7. Take hairdryer or heat gun, turn it on and point it at the candle. The upper layer of candle wax will start melting together with the tissue paper.
8. slowly pull the wax paper off. Leave the candle alone to set for half an hour.
